

Shipping YOUR BIKE to the UK in 2010

LATER SHIPMENT

July to Oct in UK/Europe

READ EVERY BLOODY WORD – SERIOUSLY!

1 January, 2009

As shipping agents Get Routed offer the following shipping service - for 2010 there will be one shipment from Australia – ex Melbourne, ex Sydney & ex Brisbane – all subject to full shipments. If there's not enough bikes to fill a container in your nearest port we will ask you to take your bike to another port for loading.

2010 dates LATER SHIPMENT

collect your bike in Felixstowe Thursday 1 July, 2010. 9am – 10am

RETURN SHIPMENT to be loaded in Felixstowe at 9 - 10am on Wednesday 20 October, 2010.

Return shipments go to the Aust port when most bikes in that return shipment came from, unless there's enough bikes for a full container to each port.

If your holiday does not match these dates, secure storage is available at the Felixstowe depot – there is now a storage charge. The first week (after unloading) is free and it's £5.00 per bike per week after that. The same applies if you're bringing you bike back to Felixstowe before I load it for the return journey.

STANDARD SIZE bikes (less than 2.3 metres long)

\$3180 Covers most bikes

Long bikes (over 2.30metres long)

PLEASE NOTE: A container is 2.30 metres wide and because we place the bikes across the width, bikes longer than 2.30m attract a higher price. With some long bikes we are able to shorten them by taking out the front wheel, putting the axle back in the forks and loading them the same as the other bikes (with the front axle in a rubber lined steel chock), thus saving you 1390 Beer vouchers. BUT bring your tools and do it yourself, we don't mess with your bike, you do! We will arrange for a forklift to pick up the front of your bike for front wheel removal.

Cost includes Container hire, sea freight, UK & Australian Customs clearance, Loading and Unloading at both ends.

The above prices do NOT include bike transport to Melbourne, Sydney or Brisbane.

For security reasons we do not advertise the names & addresses of the depots we use.

Each bike is packed securely into a shipping container on it's own individual cradle.

Shipping Insurance. The above prices **INCLUDE SHIPPING INSURANCE.**

Riding Insurance We are in contact with an insurance company who may be able to provide Fully Comprehensive cover for your bike while in the UK & Europe. We will put you in contact with them 1 month prior to loading so that your bike will be covered before Customs Clearance in the UK – Insurance cover is compulsory in the UK and is part of the Clearance process.

Loading date to be advised when the shipment is full. We require your bike approx 4 days prior to the shipping date and shipping Melbourne into Felixstowe takes 33 days. Sydney & Brisbane 3 & 6 days longer. Loading date in March is subject to shipping schedules.

PERSONAL EFFECTS CAN NOT BE CARRIED IN THE CONTAINER – Take riding boots, jackets, helmets ONLY in your Panniers & Top Boxes etc – BUT they must be unlocked and closed with sticky tape so Quarantine can inspect.

Please read this info sheet in conjunction with our Reservation form and Terms and Conditions.

TERMS and CONDITIONS for shipping bikes to and from Felixstowe

Failure to read, understand and act upon these Terms and Conditions could cause you considerable heartache and expense!!

1. Bike Cleanliness. Your bike must be spotless when packed into the container - this is a Quarantine Service requirement **YOU HAVE BEEN WARNED!!**. It is your responsibility to arrange cleaning of your bike prior to the return journey – you will receive info on how and where with the invoice.

2. PETROL TANKS must be empty of fuel. A small amount of fuel (2 litres) in the tank sufficient to get you to the nearest servo is acceptable. Also bikes must be in NEUTRAL and UNLOCKED.

3. All bikes must have their **BATTERY LEADS DISCONNECTED** and **TAPED** prior to shipping in Australia and Felixstowe. **This is your responsibility.**

4. All **Fixed Panniers** must be disconnected from the bike prior to loading, but they will be carried in the container - UNLOCKED. If you leave them locked you will be charged for the time taken to retrieve your keys from you to unload them. We will take all care possible but are not responsible for any damage during shipping so please wrap appropriately. Suggestion - Use 2 layers of plastic Bubble wrap.

5. These prices are valid from 1 January 2009 and are based current freight rates and other cost components at that time. Any cost increases will be passed on when invoices are prepared in May 2010.

6. It is each rider's responsibility to be at the Felixstowe depot on the dates provided.
The Felixstowe DEPOT address will be supplied when your deposit is received.

7. We will organise the Customs clearances, all paperwork and loading/unloading of the container.

8. Your \$600 deposit is NON REFUNDABLE. We may be able to roll it over to a later tour/shipment or refund it if you can encourage someone else to take your place, obviously at the discretion of Get Routed.

9. We require your bike approx 2 days prior to the shipping date and shipment of your bike from Australia is 36 days. You will be advised exact dates and the address to deliver your bike to the Melbourne/Sydney/Brisbane depot when we send the invoice.

10 Bookings will not be accepted without a deposit (\$600) and a completed RESERVATION FORM.

11. The balance of the cost is due not later than 1 month prior to the SHIPPING DATE of your bike. An invoice will be sent.

12. Reservations will not be accepted within 1 months of a shipping date except under exceptional circumstances such as a cancellation.

13. The following will need to be provided to depot staff in Felixstowe to collect your bike, BUT only if Get Routed staff are not in attendance.

- a. A photocopy of the two important pages of your passport.
- b. A photocopy of your bikes Australian Registration papers.

This information is required to ensure no one else has access to your bike in our Felixstowe depot. Without the originals (Passport, Bike rego and your licence) no one can claim your bike.

14. People **unable** to be at the Felixstowe depot between 9am & 10am Thursday 1 July may be charged an administrative fee of £25 for collection of their bike. Get Routed staff will be there to assist with bike collection at that time and there is no fee payable if Get Routed are in attendance. The same applies when the bikes are required at the depot for reloading prior to the return shipment.

You can ride your bike in the UK/Europe on your Australian Registration plate for up to 6 months (subject to your Aussie rego being current for that time) and using your current Australian licence for up to 3 months. An International Driving Permit (for up to 12 months) is advisable if you're staying beyond 3 months. The IDP is necessary if you're touring Europe because it's really a translation of your Aussie licence.
